


Gentlemen:

State of Hawaii, Board of Land and Natural Resources, as the fee owner of that certain real property located at Kihei, Maui, Hawaii, comprised of 77.2 acres of land identified by Maui Tax Map Key Parcel Nos. 2-2-02: 81 & 83 (the "Petition Area"), authorizes State of Hawaii, Department of Education, to file a petition for a Land Use District Boundary Amendment to reclassify the land use district boundary of the Petition Area from State Land Use Agricultural District to State Land Use Urban District for the development and construction of a new Kihei High School.

This authorization also authorizes State of Hawaii, Department of Education, to include the Petition Area in land use entitlement applications to the County of Maui for the new Kihei High School. These entitlements include, without limitation, an amendment to the Maui Island Plan General Plan 2030, and to the Kihei-Makena Community Plan, and a Change in Zoning.
