Re: Ground Water Monitoring Requirements for Recycled Water Projects

Dear Ms. Pruder:

This letter will confirm our intent to discontinue submission of quarterly groundwater monitoring reports for the Koele Golf Course on Lānaʻi, Hawaii as they are no longer required under the Revised Guidelines for Recycled Water Projects ("Revised Guidelines").

As per the January 13, 2016 approval letter from Stuart Yamada, P.E. Chief, Environmental Management Division to Ms. Virginia Pressler, MD, Director of Health, Department of Health (DOH) has simplified the ground water monitoring requirements whereby the areas for recycled water use are redefined for unrestricted, conditional or restricted in the "Reuse Guidelines, Volume II: Recycled Water Projects, January 2016." For the unrestricted areas there are no requirements to submit monitoring reports to the Department of Health (DOH). The Koele Golf Course on Lanaʻi is in the unrestricted area.

Condition 2 of the Land Use Commission Decision and Order in Docket A90-662 Koele Project Expansion, Lānaʻi Resorts, LLC dba Pulama Lānaʻi – Successor to Castle & Cooke Resorts, LLC, reads, "Petitioner shall implement a groundwater monitoring program and other measures to prevent groundwater contamination from the development on the Property, in consultation with, and to the satisfaction of, the State Department of Health."

In compliance with this condition, we have submitted quarterly monitoring reports that tie to the "Monitoring Groundwater Plan, System Construction Report," by Belt Collins in March 1995, and was approved by DOH. Our understanding of the Revised Guidelines is that this reporting is no longer required. If this is not correct, would you please let us know.
