Air Quality Study Update

Dear Mr. Frampton:

In accordance with your request, we have reviewed the revised Traffic Impact Analysis Report (TIAR) dated April 14, 2015 for the subject project as it relates to the air quality study we prepared in October 2011. In comparing the revised TIAR to that used for the air quality study prepared in 2011, the revised estimated traffic volumes are approximately 10 to 15% higher. Thus, the traffic-related air pollution emissions can also be expected to be about 10 to 15% higher.

In the October 2011 air quality study for this project, it was concluded that emissions from project traffic would likely not have a significant adverse impact on air quality in the project area. This conclusion will not change with the slightly higher traffic volumes forecast in the revised TIAR.
