

**SUBJECT: Chapter 6E-42 and Chapter 343 Historic Preservation Review –  
Environmental Impact Statement Preparation Notice for the Makila Rural Community  
Launiupoko Ahupua‘a, Lāhainā District, Island of Maui  
TMK (2) 4-7-013:001 through 012**

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the notice for the upcoming draft environmental statement being prepared for the aforementioned project, which we received on November 9, 2015. The applicant is proposing to develop a 271.175-acre area that is currently vacant and undeveloped.

Proposed development would include a rural residential community containing 150 rural residential lots; a village core containing a park, limited commercial space, a community center, and possibly a fire and ambulance substation. Seven acres within the property are proposed for dedication to the State Department of Transportation for the construction of the Lahaina Bypass. Proposed documentation for presence of cultural and historic properties identified in your correspondence includes an archaeological inventory survey report. We encourage the submission of these reports in sufficient time ahead of DEIS publication that identification of historic properties be agreed upon between the archaeological firm preparing the report and SHPD pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rule §13-276.
