If they had shown the least bit of effort to respect the 'aina, instead of treating it purely as a commodity to enhance their development, whatever the cost to the community and environment, I could condone further development, excited to see how they intend to balance the needs of the native flora, fauna, and community with their own financial considerations. An approach such as this would enrich all of us. I believe all non-native, invasive species should be eliminated and replaced with a rich tapestry of native species. I believe this should be government development policy. I believe I could get behind such a development that balanced the need for native habitat with our own and that of the tourism industry. I believe such an approach would highlight the most incredible collection of endemic species in the world and what makes our slice of paradise unique and special while simultaneously educating visitors and locals, alike, about the struggles our nativity faces to survive.

The rural nature of the North Shore will be negatively impacted by the size and scope of this development. There are ways and means to minimize, avoid, and mitigate impacts associated with construction and use of the development that have been addressed in the SEIS. However, the environmental impact assessment required of developments in the State may not require an assessment of long term cumulative impacts this development will have combined with other proposed developments in the region (Envision LÄEsie development plan, Kamehameha School development in Haleiwa) and the island at large. Cumulative impacts that should be considered are road usage, sewage production and disposal, school system capacity to handle additional students, electricity usage and grid capacity, increased usership of shorelines and ocean fisheries resources, etc.

As a resident of the North Shore, I am reminded on a daily basis how lucky I am to live here. All I have to do is walk to the beach where I see sea turtles, monk seals, coastal reef fish, magnificent waves, shorebirds, and incredible awe-inspring sunsets. Neighbors and I are often found grinning on the beach, murmuring &cmLucky we live North Shore&cm. We are truly lucky to live in this rural part of the island, away from the madness of Town, whether it be Honolulu-town or Kailua-town. If I didn&cmLucky to leave my neighborhood I would be largely unaware of the increasing development around me, except that every time I walk to the beach I cross Kamehemeha Hwy. and am reminded by the brisk flow or dead-stop of traffic. Traffic has become a daily problem for North Shore residents. Although the development will bring large benefits in the forms of additional tax base, additional construction jobs, additional long term jobs, it along with the other large development plans in the area will cause exponential traffic and congestion problems, and further reduce the rural nature of our community and the quality of life of here.

A review of the marine resources survey (Oceanit, Sept. 2012 in DSEIS pp. 1146-1192) indicates that a marine resources survey comprehensive in scope was conducted. However, the study lacked regarding coverage of marine biological resources. With only three transects (each only 100 ft long and 6 ft wide for fishes and 1.3 ft wide for benthic cover) surveyed for marine biota in each of the three bays, the report poorly represents overall bay marine biological resources. The size of the three bays combined is nearly 100 acres. The transects were situated in parts of the bays where sediment impacts are known to occur, evidenced from aerial images of silt plumes and siting of all three transects in Kuilima Bay and Turtle Bay in front of known sources of runoff, $\delta \in \Lambda da$

Despite difficult survey conditions in these bays, rough seas and poor water clarity, further marine biological surveys should be conducted to improve our understanding of the coral and fish communities in these bays. Marine biological surveys should cover a broader area of each bay and should include coral colony size class distribution, fish species, fish abundance, and fish biomass.

If development of any sort is allowed, the following mitigation activities, or similar, should be made contingencies of the development permitting.

1) Improve water quality conditions inside Kawela Bay which will improve growing conditions for the significant coral community in this bay through a) restoration of the natural flow of Kawela Stream to flow out at the West Main Drain in Turtle Bay and b) conduct watershed restoration measures to reduce future sediment and nutrient loads from further degrading Kawela Bay. This may include improvements to management of runoff from large agricultural lots on the mauka side of Kamehameha Hwy.

2) Create an ocean awareness campaign that educates mainland and foreign visitors, children, and locals alike about our ocean resources and ways and means that the resort is working to protect these resources and ways and means guests and beach users can and are protecting these resources. This campaign could include guest speakers at the resort, an ocean awareness in-house tv channel, educational tours, ocean awareness activities, ocean awareness articles on the website, and ocean awareness signage around the resort grounds and shores.

3) Manage fishing through the creation of a marine protected area at whichever bay would result in the greatest benefit to fish stocks and therefore long term benefit to fishers. The additional fish surveys mentioned above would aid in determining which of the three bays would best serve this purpose.

Best of luck to all involved with this permitting / decision-making process. I hope that everyone will keep in mind the long-term cumulative impacts of the various large-scale North Shore development plans on the rural lifestyle and our quality of life when deciding how to proceed with this project, and if the Turtle Bay expansion is permitted will consider mitigation methods suggested.
