As you probably know, the federal government shut down today because of the lapse in funding. Although we worked diligently, we were unable to complete our review of the 2nd DIES by the end of yesterday. We very much appreciate the extension to get our comments to you by October 9 and will try to meet that date. However, in the event that the shutdown lasts more than a few days, it is likely that we will not complete our review in time. In that event, we will get our review to you as soon as possible—if not by October 9, then no later than 5 days after the federal government resumes operation.
