We are in receipt of the information you transmitted to us in the above captioned matter. As you are aware, pursuant to HRS 205-6, HAR 15-15-95 requires the county to forward a complete record of its proceedings to the land Use Commission. After a review of the documents submitted we find that the record is not complete. Specifically, the transmittal is missing the following items :

- 1) Final minutes. At this time, the record includes the draft minutes.
- 2) Planning Dept.'s e-mail notice to the Applicant and agencies providing notification of the scheduled public hearing on the State SUP and County SUP.
- 3) Applicant's letter of notification and location map that were mailed to all owners and recorded lessees within 500 feet of the subject property describing the application and notifying them of the scheduled hearing date, time, and place by either certified or registered mail receipt. 4) The actual list of owners and recorded lessees as well as the certified and registered mail receipts also need to be provided.
- 5) Applicant's notice and location map published in the Maui News.
- 6) Planning Dept.'s notice of hearing published in the Maui News and the Molokai Dispatch.

Transmittal of these items is required to complete the record for hearing by the Land Use Commission
