No exceptions to the Hearings Officer's Proposed Decision and Order were filed by the parties.

On July 28, 1993, this Commission heard oral arguments in support of the Hearings Officer's Proposed Decision and Order from the Roy A. Vitousek, III, Esq., representing Petitioner, and Rick Eichor, Deputy Attorney General, representing the Office of State Planning. In response to arguments presented by the Office of State Planning, the Petitioner represented that no additional dwellings would be constructed in the petition area. In a letter dated July 21, 1993, the Planning Department of the City and County of Honolulu, stated its "support" of the reclassification and the conditions in the Hearings Officer's Proposed Decision and Order.

This Commission, upon consideration of the Hearings Officer's Proposed Decision and Order, the arguments of the parties, the record and files herein, and good cause existing and upon motion duly passed by this Commission,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission shall hereby adopt the Hearings Officer's Proposed Decision and Order as its own Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order.
