In a letter dated June 14, 1994, the Planning Department of the City and County of Honolulu, stated that it would not be present for the proceedings in Lanai City, Lanai, and further stated its support of the Hearing Officer's Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order, as amended.

This Commission, upon consideration of the Hearing Officer's Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order, as amended, the arguments of the Hearing Officer, the record and files herein, and good cause existing and upon motion duly passed by this Commission,

HEREBY ORDERS that this Commission shall hereby adopt the Hearing Officer's Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order, as amended, as its own Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order.
