**FIRST STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES SETTING FORTH FILING SCHEDULE  
FOR MOTION TO AMEND IN DOCKET NO. A87-610**

On May 13, 2014 Successor Petitioner KAMEHAMEHA SCHOOLS (hereinafter "KS") filed with the Commission a Motion to Amend the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order in Docket No. A87-610 and KS Exhibits 1 - 18 (hereinafter the "**Motion to Amend**"), requesting the Commission recognize KS as the successor Petitioner in this Docket, and that the Commission issue an order modifying the Commission's Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order dated May 17, 1988, as amended, to expressly authorize the use of portions of the property subject to this Docket for solar farm development for an interim period of time.

Along with KS, the City and County of Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting ("DPP"), and the State of Hawaii by its Office of Planning ("OP"), are parties to the Motion to Amend. It is anticipated that the Commission will hold a hearing on this Motion to Amend on June 25 - June 26, 2014.

To facilitate the Motion to Amend proceeding, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rule ("HAR") §§ 15-15-42 and 15-15-70, Successor Petitioner KS, by its attorney Jennifer A. Benck, DPP, by its attorney Dawn E. Takeuchi-Apuna, and OP, by its attorney Deputy Attorney General Bryan C. Yee, hereby agree and stipulate as follows:


1. Successor Petitioner, OP and DPP will file a list of witnesses who may be called to testify at the hearing on this matter, if any, by June 16, 2014.
2. OP and DPP will each file a Response to the Motion to Amend, along with any exhibits, by June 16, 2014.
3. Successor Petitioner, OP and DPP will file any additional exhibits/rebuttal exhibits, and a list of any rebuttal witnesses, if any, by June 20, 2014.

The parties hereto agree that this Stipulation may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and said counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument, binding all of the parties hereto, notwithstanding all of the parties are not signatory to the original of the same counterparts.




