Aloha Maija,

Thank you for coordinating with USFWS on this. I have no problems with #7, #8, and #10. I do not know if Hawaiian geese are seen often at the project site, but the #9 will not protect the goose as they move around often and a one-time survey wouldn't provide useful information. I've attached an alternate goose avoidance measure, but understand that it may be too late to include. If geese are not commonly (or ever) seen at the site, then this is probably not necessary.

1. All onsite project personnel will be apprised that Hawaiian geese may be in the vicinity of the project at any time during the year. If a Hawaiian goose appears within 100 feet of ongoing work, all activity will be suspended until the animal leaves the area of its own accord.

Aloha Rachel,

You reviewed a special permit application for a proposed quarry on the subject property in 2014 and had several comments related to protection of Hawaiian hawk, goose, bats, petrel and shearwater as well as flora. The County Planning Commission incorporated many of your recommendations as conditions of the special permit recommendation that was forwarded to the State Land Use Commission for final decision to approve or deny the permit. The LUC remanded the application back to the County Planning Commission and they will be holding a hearing on June 2nd to consider a new recommendation.

The applicant, Jas. W. Glover, Ltd. is requesting to revise some of the conditions the Planning Commission had recommended. Please review revised conditions #7 through #10 in Exhibit 4, pages 1 & 2 of the attached document COR-14-095391. The portions they are proposing to remove are struck through and the portions to be added are double underlined.

Please let me know by Friday, **May 13th** if your agency has any concerns with the proposed changes. Give me a call if you would like to discuss.
