Please accept my apologies for this late submittal (less than 48 hours), in support of the above-referenced petition.

I am aware that the Robinson Family Partners have been exceptional stewards of their lands being considered to be designated as IAL, and while the entire lands proposed for IAL designation may not entirely comply with applicable statutory requirements, I am aware that this body may grant IAL designation to the entire proposed designation if the standards and criteria for the entire requested IAL designation meets the objectives and policies for IAL.
