3. A question has been raised regarding potable and non-potable water. Please comment on the sources of irrigation and non-potable water that are available to the Lima Ola Workforce Housing Development Project.

There are no separate sources for irrigation and non-potable water. All water sources, for both potable and non-potable demands in the vicinity of the Project, are the four well sources in the Hanapepe-Eleele Water System, which is part of the County Department of Water System.

4. Does the lack of a non-potable water source raise any issues of concern for the Project?

No. The Water Master Plan takes into consideration the Project's potable and non-potable water demands. The Plan concluded that the pumping capacity and source availability is adequate to accommodate the demand for Phase 1. Water demands for subsequent phases will be re-evaluated when planning for that phase commences.
