INTERVENOR COLLEEN HANABUSA'S STATEMENT RE: (1) SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND DECISION AND ORDER; (2) VARIOUS PARTIES' SUBMISSIONS OF REQUESTS FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND DECISION AND ORDER; (3) DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU'S MOTION TO REOPEN THE CONTESTED CASE HERING FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF TAKING OFFICIAL NOTICE OF FACTS, FILED ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2016

Intervenor COLLEEN HANABUSA submitted Intervenors' Ko Olina Community Association, Colleen Hanabusa and Maile Shimabukuro Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Decision and Order, filed on July 17, 2009, towards the end of the contested case hearing In the Matter of the Application of Department of Environmental Services, City and County of Honolulu, For a New Special Use Permit to Supersede Existing Special Use Permit to Allow a 92.5 acre expansion and time extension for Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill, Waimanalo Gulch, O'ahu, Hawai'i, Tax Map Key: 9-2-03: 72 and 73. Obviously, it is no longer the submission of the Ko Olina Community Association and Maile Shimabukuro as they have since retained new counsel and are in the process of submitting their own proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and decision and order, through new counsel.

To the extent that any modifications may be made to Intervenor Colleen Hanabusa's original submission as referenced above, some additional time may be necessary. Intervenor Colleen Hanabusa would like to present arguments before the Planning Commission during which all parties are to be heard on the amount of time for any such extension for the purpose of the submission of proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order. As counsel indicated to the Planning Commission at the last hearing on the above-captioned proceedings, counsel would not be available to attend the October 12, 2016 hearing that was supposed to be just for consideration of the Intervenors Ko Olina Community Association and Maile Shimabukuro's Motion to Reopen the Contested Case Hearing to Admit Limited Additional Documentary Evidence to Correct and Error that was Discovered after the Hearing Closed, filed on April 27, 2012. Intervenor Colleen Hanabusa already filed her position statement and statement of non-appearance of counsel for that hearing, on September 22, 2016.

As a result of counsel's unavailability on October 12, 2016, counsel respectfully requests that the hearings for all motions for extensions of time and for the City's Motion to Reopen the Contested Case Hearing for the Limited Purpose of Taking Official Notice of Facts, Filed on

September 30, 2016, be set for the subsequent hearing, instead, and in balancing the ongoing issue of the City's operation of the Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill without a valid permit and the necessity of prompt decision-making as discussed by the Planning Commission, previously.

Finally, without waiving the Intervenor Colleen Hanabusa's objections on the consolidation of the cases, and objections to the requests thereto, she joins in the requests of Ko Olina Community Association in their Response to the City's Motion to Reopen the Case Hearing for the Limited Purpose of Taking Official Notice of Facts, filed on October 7, 2016, should the Planning Commission reopen the case as requested by the City over Intervenor Colleen Hanabusa's objections.
