PROJECT PRIORITIES

The master plan provides a composite picture of the County's parks and recreation system some 20 years from now for each of the districts and for the County as a whole. A further component of the master plan is to provide clear and orderly guidance for implementing the plan. This chapter describes the approach used to prioritize the improvement proposals.

The end result is a prioritized list of projects in three phases, included at the end of the chapter. Each phase provides a pool of projects to be considered for inclusion in the Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

Phase 1 = projects of highest priority and recommended for near-term implementation in years 1 through 6.

Phase 2 = projects of middle priority and recommended for years 7 through 12.


Phase 3 = projects of lower priority and recommended for years 13 and beyond. This category also includes projects that need longer lead times. So while actual construction may be programmed for the out years, preliminary activities (such as land acquisition, planning, environmental review, and permitting) may occur in earlier phases.

Input Process for Park Improvement Proposals

The process used to develop park improvement proposals and evaluate them is shown in Figure 50. Suggestions for improving parks and recreation facilities came from many sources, including the following:

- Department director and staff
- Parks Master Plan Advisory Committee
- Participants who attended public meetings—two rounds of meeting were held in each of the five districts (March 2011 and November 2011)
- Respondents to the 2011 parks master plan survey (administered in print form and online)
- Respondents who participated in the April 2012 online review
- Master plan consultants

Preliminary Filter

The planning team assembled a long list of proposals based on the suggestions and comments received through the channels listed above. At this stage, proposals were vetted through a preliminary filter based on two issues: (1) land availability and the feasibility of acquisition and (2) proposals within the scope of the parks and recreation master plan.

Prioritization Methodology

A prioritization methodology was developed with the intent of providing a fair and equitable process for evaluating the park improvement proposals. The planning team established seven evaluation factors consistent with the goals and objectives of the master plan. These factors integrate considerations of cost, the current distribution of park resources, community and Department preferences, timeliness, and numbers of park users affected. In addition to measuring relevant criteria relevance, the process was based on factors that could be scored as objectively as possible. Each factor is described below.

Cost Factor

Evaluation question: How costly is this project?

Order-of-magnitude costs were estimated by professional cost estimator J. Uno and Associates. Costs were then ranked into 3 levels:

- Low = Estimated costs is equal to or less than \$250,000

- Medium = Estimated cost is between \$250,001 and \$999,999
- High = Estimated cost is equal to or greater than \$1,000,000

Demand Factors

1. Level of Service Factor

Evaluation question: To what extent does this project allocate resources to areas that are currently underserved?

Existing level of service was based on parkland per capita, where the County median is 7.1 acres per 1,000 population. This resulted in three categories:

- Below the median = Hanalei (5.7 acres) and Kawaihau (5.1 acres)
- Approximately at the median = Līhu'e (8.3 acres) and Kōloa (6.4 acres)
- Above the median = Waimea (12.0 acres)

2. Community Factor

Evaluation question: To what extent does this project reflect the values and preferences of the community?

The rating was based on expressions of support from members of the Park Master Plan Advisory Committee, and from members of the Kaua'i community at public meetings, survey, online feedback, and other communications.

3. Department Factor

Evaluation question: To what extent does this project reflect the Department’s assessment of importance and need?

The rating was based on a score provided by the Department.

4. Opportunity Factor

Evaluation question: Is there a window of opportunity for this project?

The rating was based on an expectation that there is a near-term and/or limited time frame in which to implement the proposal.

5. Trigger Factor

Evaluation question: Does this project need to be implemented in order for other projects to move forward?

The rating was based on the proposal’s affect on other development (i.e., a “domino” effect).

6. Level of Use Factor

Evaluation question: How many people is this project likely to serve?

The Department classifies parks according to volume of

use and visibility impacts, and uses the system to help determine the level and frequency of maintenance activities. For the prioritization methodology, this system was used as a proxy to rate the relative number of park users who might benefit from the proposed improvement.

- Type I = extremely high use and visibility (regional park, stadium complex)
- Type II = high use and visibility (district park, beach park)
- Type III = medium use and visibility (community park, beach park, beach right-of-way)
- Type IV = medium use and visibility (neighborhood park, beach park, beach right-of-way)
- Type V = low use and visibility (medial strip, triangle, traffic island)

Prioritized List of Projects

For each of the five districts, Table 32 shows the list of project priorities by phase. Table 33 is a County-wide list of priorities by phase. Within each phase, lists are in alphabetical order by park name.
