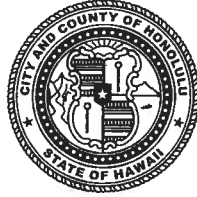

You will be notified of the hearing date and a copy of the public hearing notice will be sent to you.

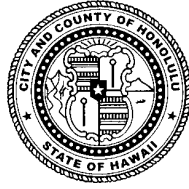
