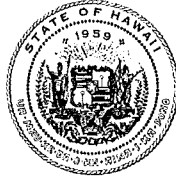

Dear Mr. Orodenker:

Pursuant to Section 15-15-42, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), on behalf of the Office of Planning ("OP"), I respectfully request an extension for all parties to file responses to Petitioner's Motion for Order Amending the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order Dated February of 10, 1995, ("Motion") for docket number A94-706. The Motion was filed on July 5, 2017, and a response is normally due seven days after being served. See Section 15-15-70(e), HAR. My office was served on July 5th, 2017. I respectfully request that all parties be given until thirty days following the filing of the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Petitioner's proposed project for the petition area.

The request for a 30-day extension is to allow time for the completion of the EIS as well as for the parties to consult with appropriate agencies on areas of concern that may be affected by the proposed Motion. Petitioner and the County's Corporation Counsel have no objections to the request for the extension.
