Your application for a Special Use Permit (SUP) to allow expansion of the Honouliuli Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) for the development of full secondary treatment and support facilities (Tax Map Key: 9-1-069: Portion 003 and 004) on approximately 27.807 acres within the State Land Use Agricultural District is accepted for processing as of July 3, 2017.
