2. LEGISLATIVE MATTERS

The Executive Officer updated the Commission on the status of LUC related bills. H.B. 1409, H.D. 2, S.D. 1 which would allow the land use commission to receive reimbursements for court reports and other expenses as determined by the commission passed legislature and will become an act pending the Governor's signature.

- 3. The Commission asked staff to request that petitioners of the following dockets appear before the Commission to give a status report:
 - a. A88-620 Kohala Joint Ventures
 - b. A92-686 Amfac Property Investment Corp. and the Housing Finance and Development Corporation (Puukolii Village)
- 4. A status on LUC docket no. A89-649 Lanai Resort Company concerning litigation matters was presented by the Commission's Deputy Attorney General Jon Itomura. Mr. Itomura reported that Judge Raffetto ruled against the Land Use Commission (that the LUC has no jurisdiction in the cease and desist and has no enforcement authority). Commissioner Ing moved and Commissioner Yukimura seconded to authorize the Deputy Attorney General to appeal Judge Raffetto's decision. The motion was carried by voice votes. It was noted for the record that Commissioner Catalani recused himself due to conflict of interest.
