On behalf of the Applicant, Hawaiian Memorial Life Plan, Ltd., HHF Planners has completed a Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for a proposed cemetery expansion project.

Since the Proposed Action involves reclassification of approximately 53.45 acres from the State Land Use Conservation District to the Urban District, a FEIS has been prepared in accordance with Chapter 343, Hawaiʻi Revised Statutes and Chapter 11-200, Hawaiʻi Administrative Rules pertaining to "Environmental Impact Statements."

The FEIS documents the technical characteristics and likely environmental impacts from the Proposed Action, and advances findings and conclusions relative to the significance of the action. It also includes comments on the Draft EIS received (postmarked) within the 45-day comment period that concluded on October 23, 2018.
