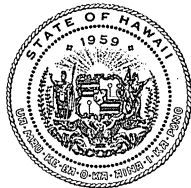

This confirms that the proposed Kapa'a Stream Bridge will be able to accommodate the installation of an eight inch sewer force main mounted to the side of the bridge. Department of Transportation (DOT) approval of the installation of the sewer force main is subject to the following conditions:

1. The developer shall submit construction drawings prepared by a licensed professional engineer for the proposed improvements for review and approval by DOT.
2. The developer shall execute a Use and Occupancy Agreement for installation of the proposed sewer line within the Kuhio Highway right of way.
3. The developer shall bear all costs associated with the sewer force main.
