The conclusion of the study indicates that the reclassification of the 97 acres of agricultural land surrounded by urban development will have a minimal impact on Kauai's ability to feed its population over time."

We disagree: MAJOR IMPACT on Kauai to feed residents, visitors, babies being born; All the 'studies' are out dated to 2020 as: overstrained/overworked: KPD, First Responders, EMT's, Medical Facilities Solid Waste Workers' - Mt. Kekaha is 120 ft above Sea Level. The proposed new municipal solid waste landfill (MSWLF) at Ma'alo, which Kauai County taxpayers have spent close to \$2-million for the EIS, is invalid due to FAA concerns.
