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ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO TERMINATE ORDER REGARDING WRITTEN STATUS REPORTS ON PROCEEDINGS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION RELATING TO COUNTY SPECIAL USE PERMIT FILE NO. 2008/SUP-2

On December 4, 2019, the Department of Environmental Services, City and County of Honolulu ("Applicant"), filed a Motion to Terminate Order Regarding Written Status Reports on Proceedings of the Planning Commission Relating to County Special Use Permit File No. 2008/SUP-2; Declaration of Kamilla C. K. Chan; Exhibit "1"; and Certificate of Service (collectively "Motion"), pursuant to Hawai'i Administrative Rules ("HAR") § 15-15-70.

The Applicant requests that the State of Hawai'i Land Use Commission ("LUC") terminate its Order Requiring Written Status Reports filed on May 28, 2014, as the proceedings at the City and County of Honolulu Planning Commission ("Planning Commission") relating to File No. 2008/SUP-2 have concluded.

The LUC's Order Requiring Written Status Reports required the Applicant to file written status reports with the LUC on the proceedings of the Planning Commission relating to County Special Use Permit File No. 2008/SUP-2 every other month starting from July 2014 with service upon the other parties in this matter.

On December 24, 2019, the State of Hawai`i Office of Planning ("OP") filed a Statement of No Opposition to Applicant's Motion to Terminate Order Regarding Written Status Reports on Proceedings of the Planning Commission Relating to County Special Use Permit File No. 2008/SUP-2.

On January 9, 2020, the LUC considered the Applicant's Motion at its meeting at the Airport Conference Center, Room #IIT#2, in Honolulu, Hawai`i. Kamilla C. K. Chan, Esq., appeared on behalf of the Applicant. Rodney Funakoshi appeared on behalf of OP. Dina Wong appeared on behalf of the City and County of Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting ("DPP"). Cal Chipchase, Esq., appeared on behalf of Intervenors Ko Olina Community Association and Maile Shimabukuro (collectively "KOCA/Shimabukuro"). Intervenor Colleen Hanabusa was served with a

copy of the Motion and was notified of the date, time, and place of the LUC's meeting on the matter but was not present or represented at the meeting.¹

At the meeting, the Applicant argued for the termination of its requirement to file written status reports. Intervenors KOCA/Shimabukuro argued for the need of an ongoing reporting obligation on the part of the Applicant to provide timely notice as well as periodic updates to the LUC, the parties, and the community regarding any plans involving the Waimānalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill. The DPP and OP stated that they had no objections to the Applicant's Motion.

Following discussion, a motion was made and seconded to grant the Applicant's Motion. There being a vote tally of 6 ayes and 2 nays, the motion passed.²


The LUC, having duly considered the arguments of the Applicant, OP, the DPP, and Intervenors KOCA/Shimabukuro, and a motion having been made and seconded at a meeting on January 9, 2020, in Honolulu, Hawai`i, and the motion having received the affirmative votes required by HAR § 15-15-13, and there being good cause for the motion,

HEREBY GRANTS the Applicant's Motion.

¹ Naomi Iwabuchi, Esq., appeared on behalf of Schnitzer Steel Hawai`i Corp. ("Schnitzer"). Schnitzer was not an intervenor in this matter and took no position on the Applicant's Motion.

² There are currently eight sitting members on the Commission. The ninth seat is currently vacant.

Accordingly, the LUC's Order Requiring Written Status Reports filed on May 28, 2014, is hereby terminated, and the Applicant shall no longer be required to file written status reports with the LUC on the proceedings of the Planning Commission relating to County Special Use Permit File No. 2008/SUP-2.
