Projects require entitlements and significant infrastructure/capital investment to proceed. Soil, topography wetland and other issues must be resolved. Significant risk in assuming any/all will be built during the study time frame. Actual supply added will likely be far less.

(1) Phase I will have 12,000 burial spaces of total build-out of 60,000. We have assumed two phases, or 24,000 spaces, will be made available in projection time-frame to 2040.
