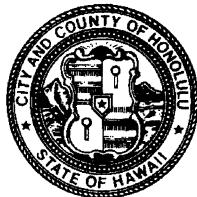



2020/SUP-6 LOCATION MAP



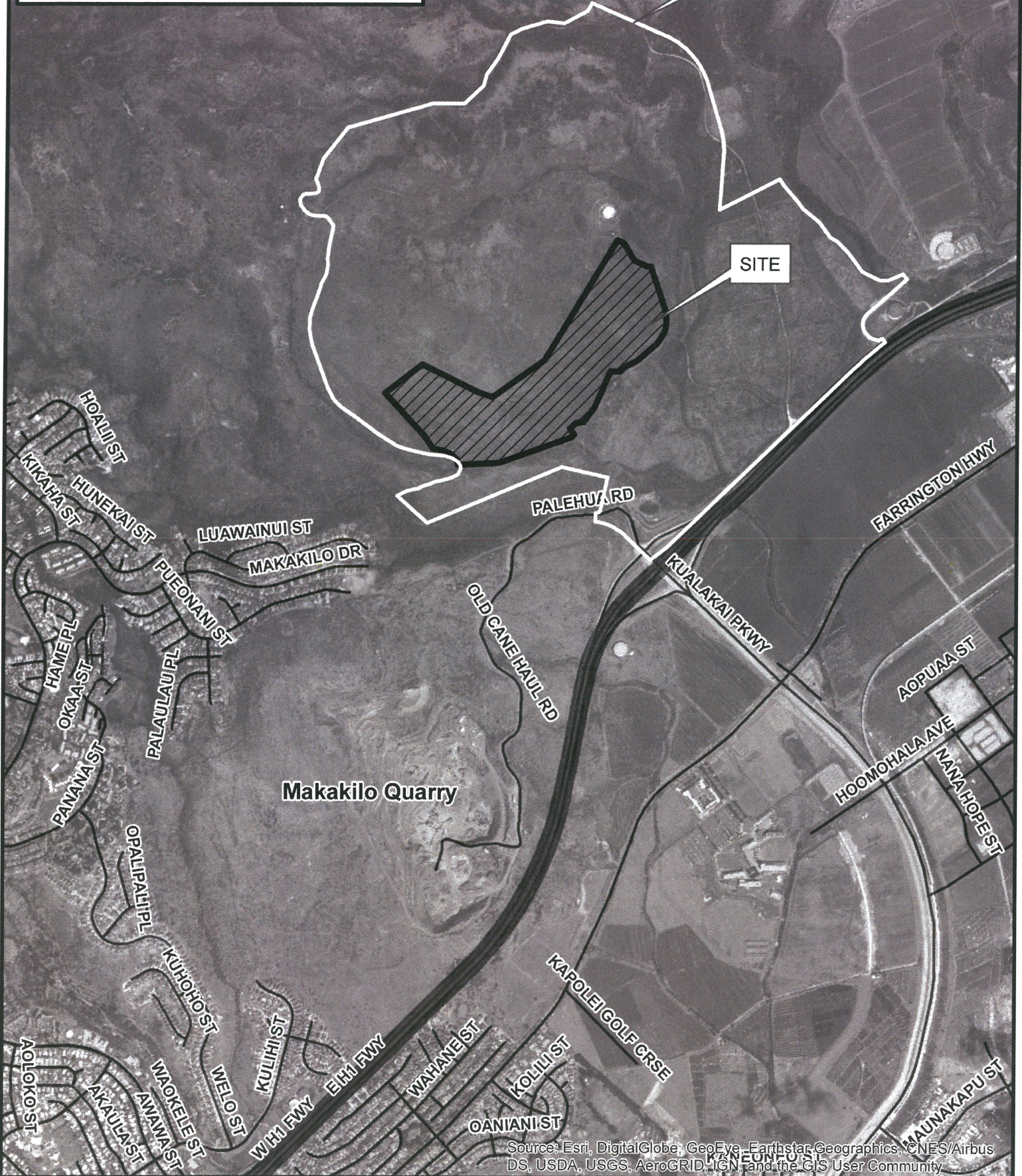
