## A84-568 - MAUD VAN CORTLANDT HILL SCHROLL TRUST

In the matter of the petition by Maud Van Cortlandt Hill Schroll Trust, a hearing had been conducted by Hearing Officer Benjamin Matsubara on September 11, 1984 and October 22, 1984.

Mr. Matsubara reported on his findings received during the hearings and on the positions taken by the government agencies.

Based on the evidence that was presented, it was Mr. Matsubara's recommendation that the reclassification of the subject property from the Urban to the Rural District was reasonable and non-violative of Section 205-2, HRS, provided that beach access was included as part of the proposed development, as required by the County of Maui or any other governmental agency.

Mr. Gary Wong, petitioner's representative, submitted that it had always been petitioner's intention to provide public access as required by the County of Maui. He also requested that the wording "any other governmental agency" as suggested in the Hearing Officer's report be deleted from the condition.

Vice Chairman Tacbian moved to adopt the proposed order recommended by the Hearing Officer, which was seconded by Commissioner Whittemore.

Vice Chairman Tacbian moved to rephrase his motion to "adopt the proposed order recommended by the Hearing Officer, provided that beach access be included as part of the proposed development as required by the County of Maui." The seconder of the motion agreed with the amended motion.

The motion was carried as follows:

Chairman Yuen instructed the Hearing Officer to prepare the Commission's Decision and Order on the subject petition.

It was announced that the Commission will reconvene tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. in the Maui Electric Company's conference room.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:55 p. m.
