HEARING

A84-577 - HAWAIIAN AIRLINES, INC.

Pursuant to a notice published in the Maui News and the Honolulu Advertiser on October 19, 1984, and notices sent to all parties, a hearing was called by the Land Use Commission in the matter of the petition by Hawaiian Arilines, Inc. to reclassify approximately 50 acres of land from the Agricultural District into the Urban District at Mahinahina and Kahana, Lahaina, Maui for an airstrip.

It was announced that the Commission was in receipt of approximately 31 requests to appear as public witnesses, and two requests for intervention--one from Mid Pacific Airlines, and another from Abraham Ahia, et al, represented by the Native Hawaiian Legal Corporation.

It was submitted by Ms. Magnier that a group of native Hawaiians who own a 9% undivided interest in Kahana Valley were concerned with the implications the airport development will have on the value of the valley.

Upon motion by Vice Chairman Tacbian, seconded by Commissioner Choy, both Mid Pacific Airlines and Abraham Ahia, et al were permitted to intervene in these proceedings, by unanimous vote.

Chairman Yuen polled all of the parties with respect to their positions relative to his participation in these proceedings, in view of the fact that his law firm had previously represented Hawaiian Airlines and Royal Hawaiian Air Service. All of the parties responded that they had no objections to his participation.
