Dear Executive Officer Oroedenker:

You sent a letter dated December 21, 2021, indicating that you wished to hold a pre-hearing conference with the parties (Successor Petitioner Kamehameha Schools (“KS”), Office of Planning and Sustainable Development (“OP”), and the Department of Planning and Permitting, City and County of Honolulu (“DPP”)), this month. By that same letter you granted OP’s request to extend OP’s filing deadline from December 17, 2021, to February 8, 2022. Prior to that letter, the above-noted parties had confirmed consent to both DPP and OP having that extended deadline.

We understand that the Commission will hold a hearing on this Motion on March 23, 2022. In light of the hearing date, and OP’s and DPP’s February filing date, KS proposes to file its reply materials (exhibits, written direct testimony, etc.) on February 25, 2022. We have discussed this with counsel for OP and DPP and they are agreeable to this scheduling.


