ACTION

SP79-333 - GEOTHERMAL EXPLORATION & DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION APPLICATION TO ALLOW THE DRILLING OF FOUR EXPLORATORY GEOTH ERMAL DEEP WELLS AT NORTH KONA, HAWAII

Chairman Duke called on the staff planner to point out the location of the property on the maps.

Mr. Yasui also presented a very comprehensive staff memorandum relevant to this Special Permit request.

Commissioner Whitesell expressed great concern over the fact that petitioners were already drilling the wells without benefit of a Special Permit, claiming that it was a permitted use within the Agricultural District as a water well.

Chairman Duke agreed that the various agencies should be notified that Special Permits were required for geothermal explorations and that this ought to be distinguishable from drilling for water.

Commissioner Carras moved that the petitioner be granted the Special Permit, which was seconded by Commissioner Oura and unanimously passed.

A78-445 - OCEANIC PROPERTIES, INC.

Pursuant to a notice published in the Honolulu Star Bulletin on January 27, 1979, and notices sent to all parties, a hearing was called by the Land Use Commission in the matter of the petition by Oceanic Properties, Inc. to amend the land use district boundaries for approximately 227 acres of land presently in the Agricultural District into the Urban District at Waipio, Oahu, Docket A78-445.

Chairman Duke announced that two timely requests for intervention-one from Gentry-Waipio and Gentry Pacific, Ltd.; and another from Richard D. Poirier of Neighborhood Board No. 25-had been withdrawn.
