#### ACTION

SP77-258 - MAKOTO NITAHARA DBA NANI MAU GARDENS APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL PERMIT TO SERVE FOODS AND DRINKS, AND TO PROVIDE ENTERTAINMENT AT THE NANI MAU GARDENS IN THE AGRI-CULTURAL DISTRICT AT PANAEWA FARM LOTS, WAIAKEA, SOUTH HILO, HAWAII
