ACTION

A79-464 - COUNTY OF KAUAI

In the matter of the boundary amendment petition by the County of Kauai, Docket A79-464, a hearing was conducted by Hearing Officer Benjamin Matsubara on February 21, 1980. Based on the findings as reported by the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Planning & Economic Development; evidence adduced at the hearing; it was recommended by the Hearing Officer that an amendment to the district boundary under subject petition was reasonable, non violative of Section 205-2 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, and consistent with the Interim Statewide Land Use Guidance Policy.

Mr. Matsubara responded to questions concerning cesspool contamination of the wells on the neighboring property, water availability, development timetable, etc.

Commissioner Pascua moved to reclassify approximately 7.155 acres of land presently in the Agricultural District into the Urban District at Kapaa Homesteads, Kawaihau, Kauai

for a residential subdivision. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Nakagawa and carried by the following votes:
