ACTION

A80-482 - T.S.K., ASSOCIATES

To determine re-application status pursuant to Rule 6-14, of Land Use Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure

Chairman Duke called on staff to elaborate on the subject request before the Commission.

Mr. Yasui, planner, explained that the present request comprised an area of approximately 240 acres as compared to approximately 90 acres requested in an earlier petition which had been denied by the Commission. He delineated these areas on the posted maps.

The Chairman added that the Commission was in receipt of petitioner's memorandum in support of the re-application. It was also noted that the re-application had been filed prior to the expiration of one year from the denial of the first petition. Therefore, oral arguments were sought from each party regarding the subject re-application.

ORAL ARGUMENTS

Examination of Mr. Fuke by Commissioner Pascua 18

Commissioner Oura moved to approve the re-application of T.S.K., Associates, Docket A80-482. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Pascua. The motion was carried with the following votes:

Chairman Duke declared that the time will start tolling from the date of receipt of the petition by the Commission on April 14, 1980, and that the Commission will conduct a hearing on this request within 60 to 180 days therefrom.

A80-480 - MAUI 100 PARTNERS

Pursuant to a notice published in the Honolulu Advertiser and the Maui News on April 25, 1980, and notices sent to all parties, a hearing was called by the Land Use Commission in the matter of the petition by Maui 100 Partners to reclassify approximately 98.78 acres of land presently in the Agricultural District into the Urban District at Pulehunui, Kihei, Maui, for residential use, Docket A80-480.
