HEARING

A82-544 - IOLANI SCHOOL

Pursuant to a notice published in the Honolulu Star Bulletin on April 27, 1983 and notices sent to all parties, a hearing was called by the Land Use Commission in the matter of a petition by Iolani School, Docket A82-544, to reclassify approximately 201 acres of land currently in the Conservation District into the Urban District at Kaneohe, Koolaupoko, Oahu for a residential development.

Chairman Yuen announced that the Commission was in receipt of four petitions for intervention, 18 timely and 4 untimely requests to appear as public witnesses.

Of the persons representing the four petitions for intervention, only Ms. Elizabeth Ann Stone was not present today.

Chairman Yuen announced that arguments will be heard from all of the parties regarding the intervention requests prior to taking action on these requests.

Following completion of the arguments by all of the parties, Commissioner Rubin moved to approve the intervention requests by the Luluku Banana Growers Association, Hui Malama Aina O' Koolau and the Neighborhood Board, on the condition that their attorneys and representative coordinate their presentations, streamline proceedings, and reduce repetitive testimony and cross examination; and to deny Elizabeth Ann Stone's intervention request. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Choy and Junanimously carried by voice vote.

Chairman Yuen declared that the 18 timely requests to appear as public witnesses, with the exception of Kathryn Albu, Frederick Shiroma, Shigeharu Shiroma, Aaron Fung, Tet Choi Fung, were approved.

Upon motion by Commissioner Chun, seconded by Vice Chairman Choy, Mr. Fred Gartley was admitted as a public witness.

At the Chairman's request, staff planner oriented the Commission to the property under petition with the aid of the USGS and Tax maps.
