A83-551 - OCEANIC PROPERTIES, INC.

He added that it was the City's position that neighborhood boards were created to provide input in an advisory role to assist the City in its decisions.

Commissioner Cuskaden moved, seconded by Commissioner Whittemore, to approve the petition of Neighborhood No. 25 to intervene, and the motion was carried by voice vote.
