Chairman Yuen announced that a request had been made by one of the Commission members to obtain further evidence from the County to substantiate the need and demand for the proposed housing project, and in order to receive this additional information, a continuation of the hearing was necessary. The Chairman called for a motion to continue this hearing until January 15, 1982. There were no objections from any of the parties.

In response to Commissioner Tacbian's request for a clarification of the need to continue with the hearing, Commissioner Cuskaden elaborated that the petitioner had the burden of proof to persuade by providing adequate facts and figures to support the need for the proposed project. Vice Chairman Whitesell added that government too should be made to meet the same kind of criteria as required of the private sector.

It was moved by Commissioner Cuskaden and seconded by Vice Chairman Whitesell to continue with the hearing until January 15, 1982. The motion was carried, with Commissioner Tacbian casting the only dissenting vote.
