ACTION

DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE LAND USE COMMISSION'S RULES AND REGULATIONS

In connection with the proposed revisions to the Land Use Commission's Rules and Regulations, the following material was passed out to the Commission for discussion:

- Legislative Acts, Amendments to Chapter 205, HRS 1.
- Proposed Changes to the Land Use Commission's Rules and Regulations

Mr. Furutani reviewed the proposed changes to the Rules, explaining whether they were merely technical corrections, or changes which were mandated as a result of statutory amendments.

During the discussion, there were suggested changes to some of the wording to more truly reflect the legislative intent and to make it clearer in meaning. The inclusion of appropriate wording in the Rules to delegate authority to the Executive Officer to make boundary interpretations was also Problems associated with criteria and time brought up. requirements in disposing of motions for defective filing, petition for intervention, request to appear as a witness were discussed. Amendments or revisions to certain requirements under the Special Permit procedure were suggested.

Chairman Duke directed the Executive Officer to prepare the proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations as discussed today for the Commission's review.
