Gentlemen:

Your request of October 20, 1966 relating to the determination of the Heeia Land Use District Boundaries as they affect the Heeia Fish Pond (TMK 4-6-05: 1) was considered by the State Land Use Commission on October 29, 1966.

Upon reviewing the Land Use District Boundaries as filed with the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawaii and made effective on August 23, 1964, the Commission has determined that the Heeia Fish Pond is classified "Conservation". This determination was based upon District Map O-12, and the following paragraph (State Land Use Regulations and District Boundaries, Part III):

"Unless otherwise indicated, all areas of the State having an elevation below high-water mark are classified "C", although the district boundary lines which reach the sea are extended, for convenience of reading, a short distance offshore. All off-shore and outlying islands of the State of Hawaii are classified "C" unless otherwise indicated."
