ORDER GRANTING LAUNIUPOKO ASSOCIATES, LLC'S, ORAL MOTION TO INTERVENE AND TO WITHDRAW MOTION TO DISMISS LAUNIUPOKO ASSOCIATES, LLC FROM THIS PROCEEDING

At the Land Use Commission's ("Commission") meeting on March 28, 2003, in Waipahu, Oʻahu, Hawaiʻi, Richard Kiefer, Esq., appearing on behalf of Launiupoko Associates, LLC ("Launiupoko"), orally moved to intervene in this proceeding and to withdraw its Motion To Dismiss Launiupoko Associates, LLC From This Proceeding ("Motion To Dismiss") filed on March 10, 2003, pursuant to sections 15-15-53 and 15-15-70, Hawaiʻi Administrative Rules ("HAR").

Also present at the meeting were James R. McCarty, Esq., on behalf of Petitioner Kuleana Ku`ikahi; Thomas D. Welch, Jr., Esq., on behalf of Kauaula Land Company, LLC; Jamie Y. Tanabe, Esq., and M. U`ilani Pau`ole, Esq., on behalf of Makila Land Company, LLC; and Russell Y. Tsuji, Esq., on behalf of the Office of Planning. The

County of Maui was not present at this meeting but had previously filed a Statement Of No Position To Launiupoko's Motion To Dismiss with this Commission on March 27, 2003.

None of the other parties in this proceeding raised any objections to Launiupoko's oral motion to intervene and to withdraw its Motion To Dismiss.

Thereafter, a motion was made and seconded to grant Launiupoko's oral motion to intervene and to withdraw its Motion To Dismiss, with the understanding that Launiupoko will be ready to proceed at this Commission's April 9 and 10, 2003, hearing on this matter. Following discussion by the Commissioners, a vote was taken on this motion. There being a vote tally of 7 ayes, 0 nays, and 2 absent, the motion carried.

ORDER

Having duly considered Launiupoko's oral motion to intervene and to withdraw its Motion To Dismiss, the oral and written arguments presented by the parties, and having determined and concluded that Launiupoko has demonstrated that it will be so directly and immediately affected by the Petition for a Declaratory Order ("Petition") filed in this proceeding and that its interest in the proceeding is clearly distinguishable from that of the general public; that its position concerning the Petition is not substantially the same as the position of a party already admitted in this proceeding; and that admission of Launiupoko will not render the proceedings inefficient and unmanageable, and a motion having been made at a meeting conducted

on March 28, 2003, in Waipahu, Oʻahu, Hawaiʻi, and the motion having received the affirmative votes required by section 15-15-13, HAR, and there being good cause for the motion, this Commission ORDERS that Launiupoko's oral motion to intervene and to withdraw its Motion To Dismiss be GRANTED.
