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# ORDER GRANTING KAUAULA LAND COMPANY LLC'S PETITION TO INTERVENE UNDER HAR SECTION 15-15-53 AND WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR ORDER LIMITING THE SCOPE OF PROCEEDINGS

On November 4, 2002, Kauaula Land Company LLC ("Kauaula") filed a Petition To Intervene Under HAR Section 15-15-53 ("Petition To Intervene"), pursuant to section 15-15-53, Hawai'i Administrative Rules ("HAR").

On March 10, 2003, Kauaula filed a Request For Order Limiting The Scope Of Proceedings ("Request For Order"), pursuant to section 15-15-70, HAR.

The Land Use Commission ("Commission") considered the Petition To Intervene and Request For Order at its meeting on March 28, 2003, in Waipahu, Oʻahu, Hawaiʻi. Thomas D. Welch, Jr., Esq., appeared on behalf of Kauaula. Also present were James R. McCarty, Esq., on behalf of Petitioner Kuleana Kuʻikahi; Richard Kiefer, Esq., on behalf of Launiupoko Associates, LLC; Jamie Y. Tanabe, Esq., and M. Uʻilani

Pau'ole, Esq., on behalf of Makila Land Company, LLC; and Russell Y. Tsuji, Esq., on behalf of the Office of Planning. The County of Maui was not present at this meeting but had previously filed a Statement Of No Position To Kauaula's Petition To Intervene And Request For Order with this Commission on March 27, 2003.

At the meeting, Kauaula stated that if its Petition To Intervene were granted, it would withdraw its Request For Order. None of the other parties in this proceeding raised any objections to the Petition To Intervene and Request For Order. Thereafter, a motion was made and seconded to grant Kauaula's Petition To Intervene with the understanding that Kauaula will withdraw its Request For Order, and further that Kauaula will be ready to proceed at this Commission's April 9 & 10, 2003, hearing on this matter. Following deliberation by the Commissioners, a vote was taken on this motion. There being a vote tally of 6 ayes, 0 nays, and 3 absent, the motion carried.

### ORDER

Having duly considered Kauaula's Petition To Intervene and Request For Order, the oral and written arguments presented by the parties, and having determined and concluded that Kauaula has demonstrated that it will be so directly and immediately affected by the Petition For A Declaratory Order ("Petition") filed in this proceeding and that its interest in the proceeding is clearly distinguishable from that of the general public; that its position concerning the Petition is not substantially the same as the position of a party already admitted in this proceeding; and that admission of

Kauaula will not render the proceedings inefficient and unmanageable, and a motion having been made at a meeting conducted on March 28, 2003, in Waipahu, Oʻahu, Hawaiʻi, and the motion having received the affirmative votes required by section 15-15-13, HAR, and there being good cause for the motion, this Commission ORDERS that Kauaula's Petition To Intervene and the withdrawal of Kauaula's Request For Order be GRANTED.
