The Land Use Commission, having considered said motion at its meeting in Honolulu, Hawaii on October 29, 1990, and there being no objections from other parties to this proceeding, hereby grants Petitioner's motion and amends

Condition Number Six of the Decision and Order dated May 17 , 1988, to read as follows:
"6. Petitioner shall appoint and fund a transportation manager whose function is the formation, use, and continuation of alternative transportation opportunities that would maximize the use of existing and proposed transportation systems. This will include construction and operation of a park and ride facility or other activities to encourage transit use or ridesharing. These activities and facilities shall be implemented on a schedule acceptable to and approved by the State Department of Transportation.

In the alternative, Petitioner may participate in a regional program for the transportation management with other developers and/or land owners. This program shall address the formulation, use and continuation of alternative transportation opportunities that would optimize the use of existing and proposed transportation systems."

All other conditions to the Decision and order dated May 17, 1988, are hereby reaffirmed and shall continue in effect.
