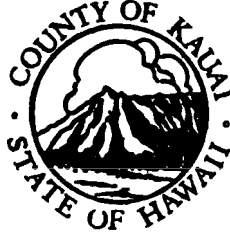

Gentlemen:

On November 20, Mr. Clinton I. Shiraishi verbally requested the Land Use Commission to consider the uncertainty concerning the location of the Urban - Agricultural Districts Boundary line affecting TMK 2-8-20: 31, Fourth Division, at Waiwala, Koloa, Kauai. Your Planning and Traffic Commission raised the same issue during our meeting at Lihue on November 5, 1964.

The Land Use Commission met in Honolulu on November 20, 1964 and considered the issue. Under paragraph 2.11, Interpretation of District Boundaries, Part II State Land Use District Regulations, the Land Use Commission, upon its own motion, determined that the Urban - Agricultural Districts boundary line includes all of TMK 2-8-20: 31, Fourth Division, within the Urban District; and includes all of TMK 2-8-20: 8, Fourth Division, within the Agricultural District.

This interpretation of the location of the Urban - Agricultural boundary line is in accord to the adjustments you seek via your petition for amendment to the Land Use Commission District Boundary submitted by letter dated November 10, 1964. It would therefore be appropriate to withdraw this petition. We would appreciate a letter to that effect for the records should you concur.
