Gentlemen:

The petition by the Lihue Plantation Company (A64-79) was acted upon by the Land Use Commission at a special meeting on August 2, 1965 in Honolulu. The Commission:

- 1) Approved all requested additions to the Lihue Urban District;
- 2) Approved removal of two parcels (approximately 2.9 acres and a 0.4 acre) from the Lihue Urban District between Hoolaka Street and the proposed Haganasulu Cutoff Road; and
- 3) Denied removal of about 8.7 acres from the Lihue Urban District between Hoolaka Street and Kalena Street.

This decision:

- 1) Enables you to proceed with subdivision plans east of Kalena and Uluhi Streets;
- 2) Adjusts the existing boundary northeast of Halsu Street to conform to the limits of the existing Lihue Industrial Park; and
- 3) Denies a boundary change between Hoolaka and Kalena Streets.

The enclosed map describes the changes effected by the Commission's decision.
