Gentlemen:

During the Land Use Commission meeting held on May 6, 1966, Mr. Jitsuo Niwao of Hilo Electric Light Company indicated that their plans for the electrical sub-station at Kauleoli, Kona will not require lands for storage of equipment, materials, etc. Therefore, it appears that a special permit is not required.

Accordingly, this Commission voted to refer the application for special permit back to the Hawaii County Planning Commission for reconsideration on the basis of the plans prepared by the Hilo Electric Light Company. Upon your reconsideration, we would appreciate hearing of the action taken.
