3. Motion for a Boundary Determination (the "Motion") was submitted by the Petitioners to the Administrative Office of the LUC on **Feb. 9, 2021** according to HAR 15-15-22 (e)..... , *ref.*,

4. Amended Motion for a Boundary Determination (the "Amended Motion") according to HAR 15-15-22 (e)..... was submitted by the Petitioners to the Administrative Office of the LUC on **March 16, 2021**..... *ref.*,

While the Petitioners have submitted numerous communications with LUC staff since June of 2020 no formal communications from the LUC regarding the scheduling of these 4 matters, or otherwise, have been received by the Petitioners. While the Petitioners raised these matters, approximately 2 weeks ago, with Commissioner Jonathan Scheuer, Chair, and Commissioner Nancy Cabral, Vice Chair (Hawai`i seat) an unintentional omission existed in that communication regarding these matters. A firm hearing date for the proceedings, 1-4 above, was not included.

We note that a firm hearing date is sometimes requested by a petitioner, *ref., LUC Docket No. A07-772, letter by the petitioner dated January 11, 2021* and it appears that LUC Docket No. A07-772 was subsequently scheduled to be heard by the Commissioners.

While we believe that our past communications on matters 1-4 (above) requested that the matters be scheduled to be heard by the Commissioners perhaps our communications were not texturally succinct in regards that we request a firm hearing date for our matters. This letter requests that a firm hearing date be set in these matters. This letter is brought according to HAR 15-15-62 (2).....

(2) Requests for information with respect to the status of a proceeding;

We apologize that our communications in these regards may seem repetitive. Our repetitive requests and the more recent intensity of our communications regarding the requests is the result of the LUC administrative office not communicating with us in these regards for a period now approaching 10 months.

We appreciate that, like ourselves, the LUC and its administrative office are very busy. However we have noted that Barry family trust amended petition was filed after ours and is now a completed docket and ours and related matters are yet to even be scheduled to be heard by the Commissioners through the end of June 2021.
