Chair Giovanni and Land Use Commissioners:


We write on behalf of Service Corporation International (SCI), the ultimate parent company of its affiliate Hawaiian Memorial Life Plan, Ltd. dba Hawaiian Memorial Park. The seven signatories comprise Service Corporation International's Office of the Chairman.

We have been involved in different aspects of Hawaiian Memorial Park's proposal to the Land Use Commission, as well as the Declaration of Conditions that resulted from the proposal. We have committed \$25,000,000 for the development, grading and infrastructure of Hawaiian Memorial Park. This includes the set aside of 100 interment spaces within the cultural preservation area for the benefit of the Ko'olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club to use for traditional Hawaiian burial practices, as well as access to the cultural preservation area, and protecting and monitoring the endangered damselfly habitat on cemetery property.


We have also attached for the Commission's reference, the May 1, 2020 letter to the Land Use Commission (*Petitioner's Exhibit #57*) from Sumner J. Waring, the Company's Chief Operating Officer, wherein Mr. Waring expresses SCI's commitment to the development of this project.


Our commitment continues and we are enthusiastic about the development and its benefits to the community.




