**Subject:** Bencorp Pre-Hearing Order

Aloha All:

Pursuant to our discussions:

A pre-hearing video conference with parties involved with Docket No. A02-737 U of N Bencorp was held on April 8, 2020. Pursuant to that discussion it was agreed and it hereby ordered that the hearing on the OSC and the Motion to Amend shall be heard no earlier than the third week of July, 2020. It was also agreed by all of the parties it is hereby ordered that:

- (1) No later than the close of business on Tuesday June 23, 2020, the Petitioner shall file with the Commission and serve upon all other parties their witness list identifying all witnesses that will be providing testimony in support of their position, an exhibit list identifying all exhibits that will be submitted in support of their position, all exhibits submitted in support of their position; and any legal briefs on the issues raised;
- (2) No later than the close of business on Tuesday June 23, 2020, the County and OP shall file with the Commission and serve upon all other parties their position statements on the Order to Show Cause ("OSC"), Petitioner's Motion to Amend, and any legal briefs on the issues raised;
- (3) No later than the close of business on Tuesday July 7, 2020; the Petitioner shall file with the Commission and serve upon all other parties any response or rebuttal to filings by the County or OP; and, any rebuttal witness list, exhibits list, and exhibits;
- (4) No later than the close of business on Tuesday July 7, 2020, the County and OP shall file with the Commission and serve upon all other parties their respective witness lists, exhibits lists, and exhibits submitted in support of their position.

Filings or submissions which are untimely may be stricken or rejected by this Commission at the time of the hearing and unless there has been a showing of good cause or lack of significant prejudice, or unless otherwise ordered by this Commission, no party shall be allowed a continued hearing in this proceeding or to submit additional exhibits not previously identified by the dates provided herein.
