

Aloha Land Use Commission Members,

Please readdress the Condition imposed in 2013 that is currently preventing occupancy of four completed buildings on the Kūlanihāko'i High School campus. Most of our students are transported to and from school either by family members or school district buses. Please consider the interim proposal to shuttle our few pedestrian and cycling students to and from school via the 14-passenger vans in our possession.

I understand that the Hawaii Department of Education is required to construct a grade-separated pedestrian transition across the Pi'ilani Highway, and that either an overpass or underpass will take several years to complete. Your temporary approval of occupancy will allow South Maui's students, beginning with the inaugural Class of 2026, to receive a full high school experience, something they are unable to do in their temporary quarters of five portable classrooms on the Lokelani Intermediate School campus.
