With the additional units sprouting up all over Wailea, traffic will become unbearable. The roundabout has blind spots for drivers and is very dangerous. Please protect the safety of our children and require that before the school opens the builders will build an overpass for students to cross the road. It's the right thing to do. It seems that an overpass could be built within a few to several months, not the 5 to 8 years that the coconut wireless has mentioned.
