### ORDER REMANDING SPECIAL USE PERMIT

On March 13, 1995, the County of Kauai Planning
Department ("Planning Department") filed a portion of the record
of the County of Kauai Planning Commission's ("Planning
Commission") proceedings on the above-entitled petition for a
special use permit filed by the County of Kauai, Department of
Public Works, Solid Waste Section, with the Land Use Commission
("Commission"), pursuant to section 15-15-95(a), Hawaii
Administrative Rules ("HAR"). On March 30, 1995, the Planning
Department filed the remaining portion of the record of the
Planning Commission's proceedings with the Commission, with the
exception of the letter of landowner authorization, which was
filed by the Planning Department on April 6, 1995.

On April 6, 1995, at its meeting in Lihue, Kauai, this Commission heard oral arguments on the Special Use Permit from Dale Burton, representing Applicant, County of Kauai, Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Section; and Jonathan Chun, Esq., representing the Planning Commission.

This Commission, having considered the arguments presented by all the parties and the record in this proceeding and there being no objections from the County of Kauai,

Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Section, and the Planning Commission to remand this matter to the Planning Commission, hereby finds and concludes that the record in this proceeding is incomplete in that it does not include the Final Environmental Assessment as well as other documents and written comments including comments from the Department of Transportation who raised concerns over the proposed project's impact upon the Lihue Airport.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition for a special use permit filed by the County of Kauai, Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Section, be and is hereby REMANDED to the County of Kauai Planning Commission for further proceedings to accept the aforementioned items into evidence.
