At the request of Mr. Raymond Young of your staff, we submit for your review a more explicit representation of the site provided in Exhibits 2-1 to 2-9 of EXHIBIT – K, Appendix E, in Grace Pacific Corporation’s SUP/CUP Application. These exhibits provide a visual perspective of the quarry from different locations in the Ewa Plain at five-year intervals during the projected life of the quarry.

This submittal should completely replace the exhibits in our previous submittal. While we were upgrading the images on these exhibits, we also refined the phasing plan for the quarry. As a result, we submit a new Figure 6 for EXHIBIT – K, Appendix B, to replace the original Figure 6 of our previous submittal.

In this new submittal, Mr. Young requested that Exhibits 2-6 and 2-8 show real-life images of the quarry for the five-year stages rather than color-coded land masses to represent the altered areas. Hence, only Exhibits 2-6 and 2-8 show the computer-generated, real-life images for the quarry’s various stages of operation. We have also included for your benefit, real-life images of the final quarry phase for all of the other viewpoints or exhibits. Moreover, because there was interest in what the quarry would look like after the quarry’s re-naturalization stage, we added another image to each exhibit illustrating the final re-naturalization of the quarry at approximately Year 2038. We hope this helps in your assessment of the project’s visual impact.


